Characteristics of FASD with implications in the CJS

- Impulsivity
- Hyperactivity
- Sensitivity to surroundings
- Impaired Judgment
- Inability to understand consequences
- Higher level conceptual thinking
- Suggestibility / Mimicry

Characteristics of FASD with implications in the CJS con't

- Learning disabilities time impairment
- Intellectual impairment
- Language impairment
- Developmental delays
- Poor concentration
- Poor memory
- Attention deficits
- Adaptive living skills

HOW DO WE KEEP THEM OUT?

- DIAGNOSIS
- INTERDISCIPLINARY/MULTISECTORAL APPROACH TO CO-ORDINATED, INTEGRATED SERVICE DELIVERY
- ALLOCATE NEW/SHUFFLE EXISTING RESOURCES TO SUPPORT AND PREVENTION
 - Housing
 - Supportive, not punitive services

REFORM CRIMINAL CODE

 INCLUDE ESCAPE CLAUSES IN MANDATORY MINIMUMS IN SENTENCING

 INCLUDE FASD AS A MITIGATING FACTOR IN SENTENCING

MIMIC YCJA

• AMENDMENTS TO CRIMINAL CODE

- YCJA S.34 ALLOW FOR FASD ASSESSMENTS
- YCJA S.25 ENSURE COUNSEL
- YCJA S.19 CASE CONFERENCING

CORRECTIONS ACT

 INCLUDE THE DUTY TO ACCOMMODATE INDIVIDUALS WITH FASD IN THE CORRECTIONS ACT

 REVIEW STANDARDIZED CHECKLISTS AND RISK ASSESSMENT TOOLS USED IN CORRECTIONS TO ENSURE VALIDITY AND RELIABILITY FOR PERSONS WITH FASD


