Aim to assimilate First Nations

Permits the federal government to regulate and administer every aspect of First Nations life

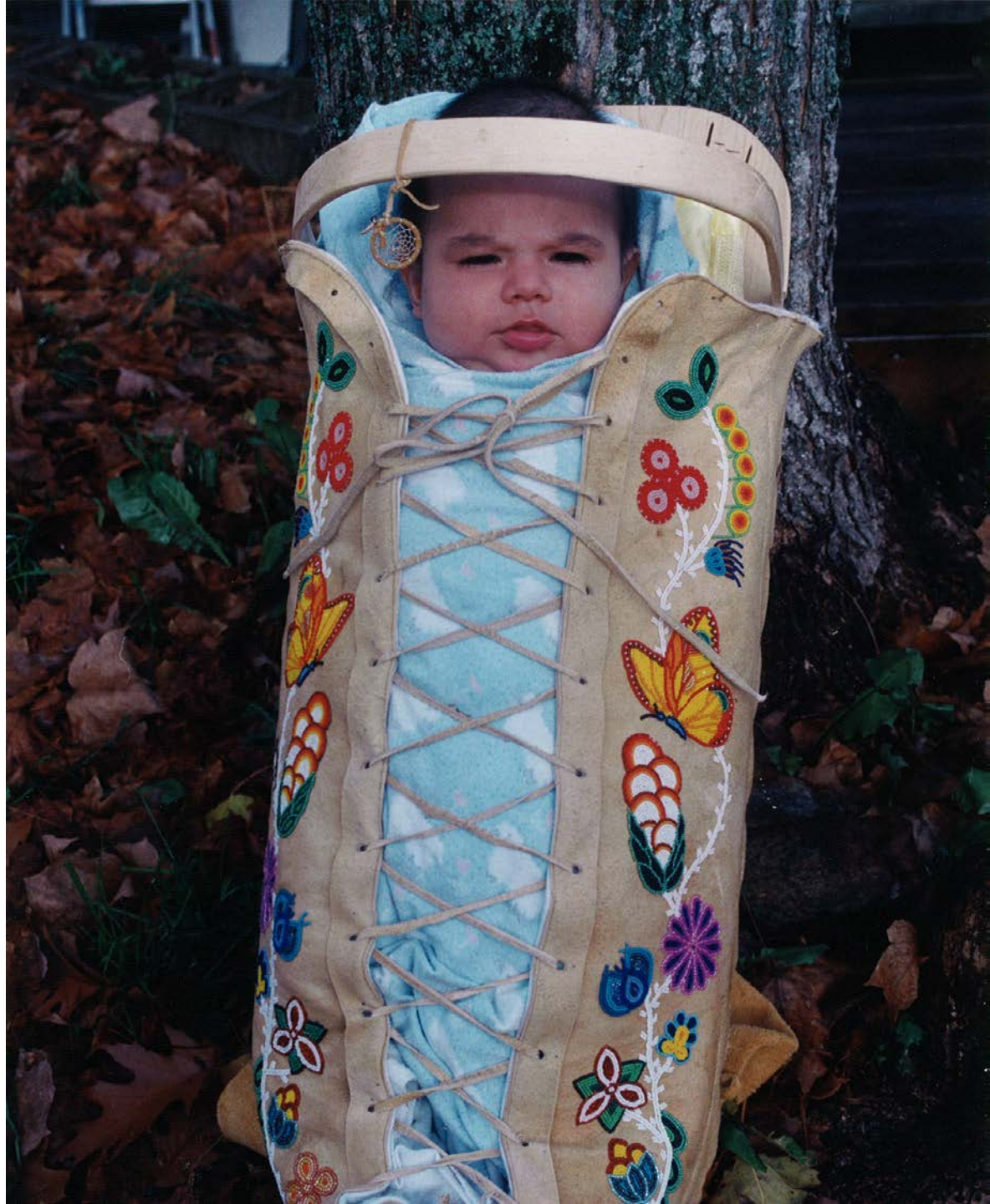
